### Latest Features in Barkeep 4.9

Feature	Description	BarkeepApp	BarkeepOnline
Inactive Items	Improved Item management with a new feature that allows you to make Items inactive. For example, Items you no longer stock will remain in your older Inventories but can be marked inactive. They will not appear in your Items List when you are taking an Inventory. You can reactivate Items as needed, for example seasonal products.	yes	yes
Serving Price Serving Size	A new feature that allows users to add an optional Serving Price and Serving Size for Items. The information can be included in Usage Reports.	yes	yes
Expanded Report Options	User control of Report Settings has been improved and allows for incorporating more optional data into Barkeep Reports including Serving Price, Serving Size and Retail Value. Summary Reports can now be organized by Location.	yes	yes
Report Sharing	By default BarkeepApp still shares Reports by email directly from your <b>iOS</b> Device. With BarkeepApp 4.9 users have the option to also share and download Reports with Airdrop and <b>iCloud</b> .	yes	n/a

Item Categories	Categorize Items (Call Liquor, Wine, etc.)	yes	yes
Items in different sizes and containers	Barkeep has been designed for you to create separate Items for every different size of the same product you stock (e.g., kegs, cans, bottles of different sizes such as 750 ml and 1l).	yes	yes
Copy Items	Save time when adding new Items by copying an existing, similar Item and then modifying it.	yes	yes
Category Groups	There are two levels of Categories – Categories and Category Groups. For example, by default Barkeep Creates the Category Group “Liquor” with Categories “Well Liquor” “Call Liquor” and “Premium Liquor.”	yes	yes

Customized Data	Barkeep is pre-installed with a small set of default Items, Categories, Category Groups and Locations. You can add, delete and set-up your data to suit the needs of your business. Inventory-specific Prices	You can override the default Item price in a Receiving or Return Inventory. This allows you to better track product that you Receive for free or at a discount. Add Items to Inventory by name	You can scroll or search and add Items to an Inventory by name.	yes	yes
Auto-Reduce name search	When you are searching and adding Inventory Items up by name, the list automatically reduces as you type each letter.	yes	yes
Scan and create a new Item	When you scan an Item that Barkeep does not recognize, you can choose to add the new Item and manually enter the details.	yes	n/a
Search and add Items	During an Inventory, before you create a new Item, you can search Barkeep's online database and automatically add the Item to your Items List.	yes	yes
Add Partial Bottles	Barkeep supports adding partial bottles, you can estimate the quantity and add it to an inventory by decimal fractions (e.g., .35, .85, etc.) or you can weigh bottles for greater accuracy (see below).	yes	yes
Inventory by Weight	Rather than estimating the amount of liquor in a partial bottle, Barkeep allows you to weigh the bottle and enter the quantity by weight. This allows for accurate, detailed Inventory results. You can track usage to 1/10 of an oz. This is extremely useful when you're tracking a Category (e.g., Premium Liquor) on a daily basis – or for a Banquet when you want to determine exactly how much was served. Weights can be entered in ounces, pounds and ounces, kilograms or grams.	yes	yes

Auto Weighing	After selecting the Item and placing it on the scale, the new Auto Weighing feature automatically enters the bottle weight to your Inventory. <b>Note:</b> Only when using a digital scale certified to work with BarkeepApp.	yes	n/a
Bluetooth Digital Scale	BarkeepApp is integrated with three models of Bluetooth digital scales including the <b>Escali SmartConnect</b> digital scale.
